Born in 1988 in Enna, Italy

Diego Miguel Mirabella investigates the relationship between language, image, and gesture, aiming to translate poetic forms of thought into visual objects. His practice unfolds through distinct yet interconnected projects, often emerging from travel, encounters, and collaborations with artists and artisans from diverse cultural contexts. Drawing and ornament function as tools of passage — surfaces where signs, patterns, and images interact, generating tension between structure and intuition, repetition and deviation. His work operates as an open system in which manual making becomes a mode of thinking and storytelling.

He is the co-founder of [LiriOne](#), an artist-run space.

Pensieri selvaggi ( 2024-26 - Ongoing)

*Pensieri Selvaggi* is the result of a journey and originates from a gesture. It began in 2024 in Jaipur, where I created a series of canvases using traditional woodblock printing. The motifs, usually employed for repetitive decorative patterns, became material for layered, non-serial images.

After returning, I intervened on the surfaces with graphite silhouettes of my hands, merging with the printed patterns — sometimes concealing them, sometimes revealing them through transparency. I see these works as travel and landscape drawings, like snapshots in which hands enter the frame.

The title refers to Claude Lévi-Strauss's concept of wild thought and to the figure of the *bricoleur*: a way of constructing meaning through available materials, guided by an intuitive and non-linear logic rooted in experience.

Il buffone (2023)

I created a bronze tree composed of rose, oak, and beech branches, entirely adorned with ornaments traditionally used in the production of bells.

The title invites the viewer to see the tree as a storyteller — one that has journeyed through different places and cultures, carrying its tales into the present.








El asunto Miguel (2022 - ongoing)


*El asunto Miguel* stems from my encounter with artisans practicing mate burilado, a pre-Inca technique of carving ornamental gourds widespread in some regions of Peru. I shared personal phrases and suggestions with the craftworkers, blending them with traditional Andean visual expressions.


The works are presented on bases I specifically created using a variety of techniques and materials — visual explorations of travel and narrative across the South American landscape.





But Me ( 2017 - Ongoing)


